GAS GAS ALSO SUCCEEDS IN THE WOMEN'S TRIAL

Villar Pellice, Italy, 2 October 2005.- Two new awards have joined the already full trophy shelves of GAS GAS in trial: The second place at the Women's Trial World Championship and the European Trial Women's title, achieved by the German rider Iris Krämer (GG TXT 250) in Villar Pellice, Italy, which staged the two last rounds of both championships at the weekend. Two other GAS GAS riders, Rosita Leotta and Rebecca Cook, riding their GAS GAS 250 bikes, put the icing to the cake by climbing onto the third step of the rostrum, Rosita in the World Championship and Rebecca in the European one. France's Claire Bertrand, also with GAS GAS, was fourth in the World Championship and fifth in the European respectively.

With these great results, the women have completed an excellent and productive 2005 season for the Catalan manufacturer, who have added a great number of titles so far: The Indoor World Trial Championship – the third consecutive one – for Adam Raga, as well as Jeroni Fajardo's third place in the final standings; the Youth Cup won by Daniel Oliveras; the Gold Medal at the 2005 World Games by Raga and Fajardo, representing Spain together with Marc Freixa; the Champion and Runner-up spots at the European Trial Championship for Shaun Morris and Jérôme Bethune respectively; and the Junior European Trial Cup for Daniel Oliveras.

There is yet another title to add to all these: the fourth manufacturers' title won by GAS GAS at the Trial of Belgium, as well as the wins achieved in all the classes competing at the Trial des Nations by GAS GAS riders who were members of all the winning national teams: Adam Raga in the Men's competition, Iris Krämer and Sabrina Weindl in the Women's, and three out of the four American team riders who won the International Trophy (Geoff Aaron, Chris Florin, Keith Wineland).
