Key Items:

Trial competition will be run under AMA rules:

Link: AMA Rules

- All riders MUST hold a current AMA membership.
- All eligible participants must be fully vaccinated.
- All riders MUST enter online.
- All riders must have correct colour nameplates.
- All riders must have protective riding gear as per AMA rules.
- Bike Types: Only trial type motorcycles allowed. Petrol and Electric Mini Bikes for juniors acceptable.
 - o No motocross, trail or enduro bikes allowed.
- Riders: Each Ride must produce the completed self-scrutineering checklist of their bike before riders briefing.
- Highest series points over 4 rounds are <u>eligible</u> for the Series awards (also see work a-round guideline below)
- In the event of a series tie of any place getter, their highest place at the final round 4 will be awarded the higher place. Any individual round tie as per Trials Rules.
- NO PRACTICE before riders briefing.
- First Aiders will be onsite.
- Number of sections and Laps will be discussed at riders briefing.
- NO riding of motorcycles in car park.
- All motorcycles to have an "engine cut-out lanyard" and must be "attached to the rider and bike at all times during riding".
- Refer to the AMA (Australian Motorcyclist Association) for all legal requirements.

Classes:

- T6 Juniors Mini type bikes ride from the start gate to the end gate only (no arrows)
- T5 Juniors (U16) White arrows and number plate
- T5 White arrows and number plate
- T4 Blue arrows and number plate
- T4+ Blue arrows with a '+' and number plate
- T3 Yellow arrows and number plate
- T2 Red arrows and number plate

Note: Some classes may be removed if there are insufficient entries

- Side cars \$35
- Family (max 2 adults and children U18, all residing at the same address) \$50
