## **Expression of interest:**

If you're interested we'd like you to give us some information about yourself and perhaps a short paragraph in support of your application.

You will need to:

- Be over 18 years old.
- Have your own capable, clean and tidy modern bike that will pass machine examination by the technical control at the event.
- Hold a current National Motorcycling Australia or FIM licence.
- Be physically capable of carrying out the task which is quite intense.
- Be available from Wednesday afternoon prior to the event.
- Be available to assist the rider, if required, at the end of each day's competition.
- Generally assist the rider who is visiting and competing in a foreign country.

This represents a great opportunity for riders to gain exposure to International Trials, mix it with the world's best and build a valuable network which could be of huge benefit in the future.
