#### 1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

Trials Club of Canberra, hereafter called the PROMOTER, will conduct a One Day National Trial for solo competitors at 705 Pialligo Avenue, Pialligo, ACT on **Sunday 16th July 2017** 

#### 2. JURISDICTION:

- 2.1. The above-mentioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling NSW Limited (MNSW) who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number 7/17/0/21788 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National and Restricted National, Competition Licences.
- 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, the By-Laws of MNSW and any Final Instructions. By entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws and instructions.

#### 3. EVENT OFFICIALS

#### 4. ENTRIES:

- 4.1 Entries open forthwith and must be received by Friday 7th July 2017.
- 4.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Trials Club of Canberra, if such retention is approved by MNSW.
- 4.3 Only entries received on the official Entry Form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- 4.4 Any entry monies paid on the day will be \$150 per rider.
- 4.5 ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PROMOTER.

#### 5. ENTRY FEE:

- 5.1 \$80-Senior, \$40 -Junior, \$120 Family (1 senior and up to 3 Juniors ALL living at the same address), \$35-Minder
- 5.2 Payment by Cheque, Money Order, or EFT deposit. Any Fees For Dishonoured Cheques Will Be The Responsibility Of The Entrant.

#### 6. ENTRY PASSES: N/A

#### 7. INSURANCE:

- 7.1 National Capital Benefits Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 7.2 Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees. It is strongly recommended that competitors give consideration to taking out weekly benefits insurance.

#### 8. MEDICAL SERVICES:

#### 9. SCRUTINEERING

- 9.1 Scrutineering will begin at 8:45am until 9.40am, on 16/7/17, when Machines will be impounded until the start at 10am.
- 9.2 Machines entered in the competition must have successfully passed a machine examination prior to taking part in practice & competitor.
- 9.3 Current competition licences and full riding gear must be presented at scrutineering. Eligibility checks can take place at any time during the meeting. Machines which suffer accident damage in practice or race sessions must be re-examined before participating again.

#### 10. CLASSES OF COMPETITION:

10.1 The event will have sections set for the following rider grades, and appropriate grade lines:

Expert (Green Rider Name Plate, green section splits)

A (Red Rider Name Plate, red section splits)

B (Yellow Rider Name Plate, yellow section splits)

Masters (Yellow Rider Name Plate, yellow section splits)

C (Blue Rider Name Plate, blue section splits)

Veteran (Blue Rider Name Plate, blue section splits)

Club (White Rider Name Plate)
Junior (White Rider Name Plate)

#### 11. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

- 11.1 To constitute a Class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each Class shall be five (5).
- 11.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any Class of Competition, the decision to run or cancel the Class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards, will be at the discretion of the Trials Club of Canberra.

#### 12. STARTS & FINISHES:

The event will start at 10am & finish time will be notified at the Rider's Briefing.

#### 13. FLAGS & SIGNALS: N/A

#### **14. COMPETITION FORMAT:**

14.1 The number of sections and laps will be advised at the Rider's Briefing.



- 14.2 Clubman, Junior and Sub-Junior will ride anywhere within section boundaries and/or may be restricted further.
- 14.3 Expert, A, B, C, Veterans & Masters Riders will be further restricted.
- 14.4 Scoring will be as per GCR 23.12.3.2 -Trials.
- 14.5 There will be a 90 second time limit applied for all competitors per section.

#### **15. EVENT SCHEDULE:**

- 15.1 Competitors to present their motorcycle to the Scrutineer from 8:45am till 9:40am.
- 15.2 Competitors must present their Competition License (and log book for juniors) to the Race Secretary to confirm their entry before the Rider's Briefing at 9:40am.
- 15.3 While entries received on the day will incur a cost penalty, all riders and minder entries must be received and processed before the rider's briefing. Riders and minders entries will NOT be accepted after this time.
- 15.4 Competition will commence after the rider's briefing, approximately 10am.
- 15.5 For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed as 8am. The completion of the meeting for the Official, Observer, Rider, Minder and support crew being the completion of his/her participation in the meeting.

- 22.3 Riders Briefing Sign on sheets may be used, and must be signed after the Riders Briefing by the Competitor and Minder as proof of attendance.


