

1. <u>ANNOUNCEMENT:</u>

Denman Motorcycle club, hereafter called the PROMOTER, will conduct a Two Day National Trial for solo competitors on Twinshock machines at, Mt Rest, Golden Highway Sandy Hollow, NSW 2333 on **Sunday 9th & Monday 10th June 2019**

2. JURISDICTION:

- 2.1. The above-mentioned Two Day Open meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling NSW Limited (MNSW) who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number x/xx/O/xxxxx and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National CompetitionLicences riding a Trials motorcycle.
- 2.2. One Event Licences will be accepted, but must be purchased prior to the event and details supplied with your Entry Form prior to Close of Entries.
- 2.3. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, the By-Laws of Motorcycling NSW and any final instructions.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES:

- 3.1 Entries open forthwith and must be received by us by **Thursday 6th June 2019**
- In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the promoter, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling NSW.
- 3.3 Only entries received on the Official Entry Form that are accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- 3.4 NOTE: NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED, AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PROMOTER.

4. INSURANCE:

- 4.1 National Capital Benefits Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 4.2 Personal Accident and Ambulance Insurance is the responsibility of the individual.
- 4.3 IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE DUE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT SUCH INSURANCE COVER.

5. MEDICAL SERVICES:

St. Johns Medical services will be in attendance.

6. ENTRY FEE:

- 6.1 Two day entry Senior \$80, Junior \$40, Minder \$40 (Single day entry Senior \$40, Junior \$20, Minder \$20 each.)
- 6.2 Payment to be made by Cheque, Money Order or EFT deposit only.

8. <u>CLASSES OF COMPETITION:</u>

8.1 The event will have sections set for the following rider classes, and appropriate grade lines:

Trial 1 (Expert) Green nameplate
Trial 2 (A) Red name plate
Trial 3 (B) Yellow name plate
Trial 4 (C) Blue name plate
Trial 5 (Club-person) White name plate
Juniors (Under 16) White name plate

Score cards will designate riders' grade as all bikes will be of classic /Twin shock design.

- 8.2 Your score card should be the colour of the line you are entering.
- 8.3 The intention of the Organiser is to put the onus on the rider as to which class they enter.

9. <u>AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:</u>

- 9.1 Trial 1 through to Trial 5, 1st, 2nd, 3rd.
- 9.2 Points only awarded to riders onboard motorcycles as per MOMs Pre '65 and Twinshock.
- 9.3 Mono Style bikes welcome, BUT NO POINTS will be awarded towards NSW Twinshock Championship.

10. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

- 10.1 For all championship classes, the number of entries received at the closing date will determine if the number is sufficent to constitute a championship. The closing date will NOT be extended and if there are insufficent numbers, that class will not be run as a championship.
- 10.2 To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be three (3).
- Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards, will be at the discretion of the promoter, subject to Motorcycling NSW approval.

11. COMPETITION FORMAT

- 11.1 The number of laps, and sections, will be advised each day at the Riders Briefing.
- 11.2 Competitors to present their motorcycle to Scrutineering Sunday 8.45am to 9.30am and Monday Scrutineering 8.00am to 8.45am
- 11.3 Competitors must present their Competition licence (and Log book for Juniors) to the Race Secretary and sign on, to confirm entry prior to the Riders Breifing at 9.45am Sunday and 8.45am Monday
- 11.4 Results will be announced and awards presented in the area adjacent to the score van once the event has concluded and all scores are tallied.
- 11.5 Scoring will be as per GCR 18.11.3.2 -TRIAL.

12. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 12.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for TRIAL competition.
- 12.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
- 12.3 A competitor may finish the trial on a machine other than their own, provided they have first obtained the approval of the MA Steward.
- 12.4 Noise &/or Fuel Testing may be carried out at any time during this meeting.
- 12.5 Trials bikes only.

13. RIDING NUMBERS:

13.1 All Nameplates on Machines MUST comply with the GCR rules pertaining to Trials machines. Headlights are not acceptable.

14. GRID POSITIONS: N/A

15. RIDERS BRIEFING:

A Riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of the Trial on each day, and all participants MUST attend. Riders' briefing sign-on sheets must be signed by the competitor as confirmation of attendance. Sunday 9.45am for 10.00am start. Monday 8.45am for a 9.00am start.

16. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

By order of Motorcycling NSW, random drug &/or alcohol testing of participants (i.e. officials, competitors, mechanics, pit crew and any other person associated with the control, direction and operation of the competition) may take place prior to, or at any time during this meeting.

17. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All participants, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia – CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate 3uthoriz at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and shall be enforced.


