1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Pacific Park Trials Club will conduct a two day National Trial for Solo Trial competitors at the Pacific Park Motorcycle Complex, South Maroota, on Saturday 31st July, and Sunday 1st August 2021.

2. JURISDICTION

2.1 The abovementioned meeting has been authorized by Motorcycling NSW which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number [Insert Permit Number] and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Licenses riding a Trials Motorcycle.

2.2 The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCRs) contained in the Manual of Motorcycle Sport, these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling NSW. By entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws and instructions.

4. ENTRIES

4.1 Entries are now open, and close last mail Sunday 26th July at 9pm. Late entries will not be accepted.

4.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Pacific Park Trials Club, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling NSW.

4.3 Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.

4.4 Entry fees will only be refunded if a rider informs Pacific Park Trials Club, before last entries on Sunday 26th July at 9pm.

5. ENTRY FEE

5.1 Two day entry Senior \$100, Junior \$50, Minder \$40 (Single day entry Senior \$75, Junior \$40, Minder \$30 each.)

5.2 Payment by EFT, Money Order or Cheque only. Any fees for dishonoured cheques will be the responsibility of the entrant. Make Payment to: Pacific Park Trials Club

5.3 Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to the Pacific Park Trials Club.

5.4 Please include your email for confirmation of entry, the issuing of entry passes and/or any final instructions at the Promoters discretion.

6. Pacific Park indemnity forms must be filled in on entry to the Park. These are available either at the Park shop, or at sign in.

7. INSURANCE

7.1 National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.

7.2 Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.

8. MEDICAL SERVICES

St John Medical Services will be in attendance.

9. SCRUTINEERING

9.1 Scrutineering will begin at 8am Saturday 31st July (and 8am Sunday 1st for those only competing on Sunday).

9.2 Machines entered in the competition must have successfully passed a machine examination prior to taking part in the event. (including Minders bikes)

9.3 Current competition licenses must be presented at sign in. Eligibility checks can take place at any time during the meeting.

10. CLASSES OF COMPETITION

The event will have sections set for the following rider classes, and appropriate grade lines:

Trial 1 (Expert) Green nameplate, Green section splits. Trial 2 (A) Red name plate, Red section splits Trial 3 (B) Yellow name plate, Yellow section splits Trial 4 (C) Blue name plate, Blue section splits Trial 5 (Club-person) White name plate, White section splits Women, Blue name plate, Blue section splits Masters 35 and over, Yellow nameplate, Yellow section splits Veterans 40 to 55, Blue nameplate, Blue section splits Veterans 55 and over, Blue nameplate, Blue section splits Youth (13 under 19) Yellow plate, yellow section splits Juniors (9 to under 16) Blue name plate, Blue section splits, under 125cc Juniors (7 to under 13) White Nameplate, White section splits, under 80cc Juniors (7 to under 11) Black Nameplate, no section splits, under 80cc

Twinshock, and Classic bikes are welcome to enter and ride, but there will be no specific classes for these bikes.

11. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS

11.1 To constitute a class for the purpose of gaining Championship status, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be minimum 5. [Refer to GCRs for details of classes]

11.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine classes and events and re-distribute any awards, will be at the discretion of the Pacific Park Trials Club subject to Motorcycling NSW approval.

12. STARTS AND FINISHES

12.1 The number of laps, and sections, will be advised each day at the Riders Briefing.

12.2 To start competitors must have previously presented their motorcycle to Scrutineering on Saturday between 8.45am to 9.30am for inspection and approval.

12.3 Competitors must present their Competition licence (and Log book for Juniors) to the Race Secretary and sign on, to confirm entry prior to the Riders Briefing at 9.45am

12.4 Results will be announced and awards presented in the area adjacent to the score van once the event has concluded and all scores are tallied.

11.5 Scoring will be as per GCR-TRIAL.

15. EVENT SCHEDULE

15.1 Event grounds open for entry 7.30am Saturday 31st July 2021

15.2 No practice on course allowed. No entry into competition sections allowed prior to event start (any day, including any days since course is set). Event exclusion for breaches.

15.3 Riders briefing 9.45am 31st July 2021.

15.4 Event start 10am 31st July 2021.

15.5 For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 7.30am, with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

16. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY

16.1 Trial 1 through to Trial 5, and other classes as listed in 10 above.

16.2 Points only awarded to riders onboard motorcycles as per MOMs for Trial Motorcycles.

16.3 Minimum class size of 5 entries to constitute a valid class.

17. LICENSES

17.1 All Participants must be holders of a current MA license. Either Senior or Junior National, or Senior or Junior Restricted, or MA One Event License. Recreational licenses will not be accepted.

17.2 MA One Event Licenses are available via the Ridernet website. They are not issued by Pacific Park Trials Club, and cannot be issued on sign up. Please organize these online before the event if you wish to use the one event license system. Please bring proof of license to sign on.

17.3 All minders must be holders of one of the above MA license types. Minders will be deemed competitors for points covered in these regulations.

18. PRESENTATIONS

At completion of event.

19. MACHINES AND RIDERS

19.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Trial competition.

19.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.

20. RIDING NUMBER BOARDS

20.1 All number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCRs and must not contain any decals or advertising other than the required MA decal.

21. GRID POSITIONS

Not applicable.

22. RIDERS' BRIEFING

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which ALL competitors MUST attend. Minders included.

23. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION

As per rider briefing.

24. ANTI-DOPING POLICY

24.1 All competitors, crew, parents / guardians and officials are advised that drug testing may take place in accordance with MA's Anti-Doping Policy, under the authority of Sport Integrity Australia.

24.2 Athletes are advised to download the Sports Integrity Australia app. If athletes have any doubts over Sports Integrity Australia requirements they should visit the website <u>www.sportintegrity.gov.au</u> It is recommended athletes contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline (1300 027 232) for further information. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed, at the discretion of MA, until the results of the tests are known.

25. DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING

25.1 All competitors and officials are advised that random drug and alcohol testing may take place during the competition. Refer to MA website for details on the Safety Policy – Drug and Alcohol testing.

26. CODES OF BEHAVIOUR

26.1 All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of MA's Codes of Behavior contained within MA's Member Protection Regulations, found at <u>www.ma.org.au</u> which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. These Codes of Behavior apply to this meeting and will be enforced.

27. ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS AND SOCIAL MEDIA

27.1 All competitors, officials and parents are bound by of MA's Social Media Policy, found at <u>www.ma.org.au</u>, which sets out a framework for acceptable online behavior where communications involve fellow MA members, volunteers, officials, coaches, sponsors, partners, staff and any other connected persons, penalties may apply for breaches of the policy.

28. ENVIROMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

28.1 All teams and riders are responsible for the removal of all items including rubbish from their pit area as they vacate the premises. Penalties may apply as per GCR 6.1.1.1 a)

29. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

29.1 Presentations etc. Adjacent to score van when all results have been finalised

- 29.2 Facilities: Portable toilets will be provided.
- 29.3 Admission Charges: Entry is free, observers, supporters and spectators are encouraged!

29.4 Camping: Available. Fees payable to Pacific Park Motorcycle Complex. Please see www.pacificpark.com.au for details.

29.5 Injuries: All injuries MUST be reported to the Clerk of the Course

29.6 Pit Area: Riding of machines in the pit area must not exceed walking pace

29.7 Car Park: Riding of machines in the car park must not exceed walking pace

29.8 Animals: No Dogs! (Guide dogs excepted) Animals are not permitted within the confines of the complex unless they are being used to alleviate a person's disability. Anyone found to have brought an animal onto the premises will be asked to leave.

29.9 Score Van: The score van is off limits to all persons. Exemptions will be made to officials of the meeting.

30. FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

30.1 Any final instructions will be provided at the Riders Briefing.
